Thank you for all that you do! Here is a summary of what's going on in the Marketing department.

It's a new year, time to get our financial ducks in a row! Please take a few minutes to review your MYADP account and confirm your mailing address is current. Also, review your Federal and State withholding amounts to be sure they are accurate for the new year. This is especially important if you started mid-year or moved from part-time to full-time and may have estimated a lower tax rate last year.

2021 W-2s are available in the MYADP app. Log in and go to Pay. Scroll down to Tax Statements and you will see the W-2 listed. Click View statement. It will ask for two step authorization. Paper copies will be distributed or mailed by the end of January.
